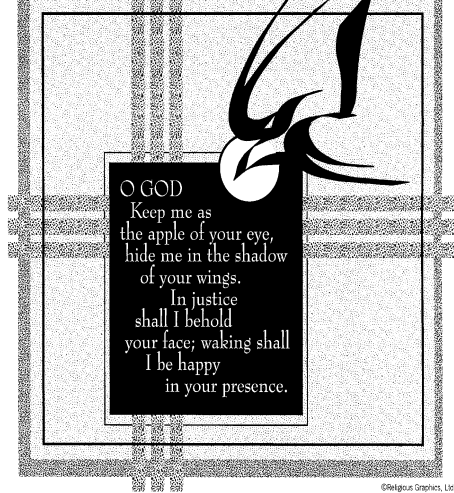


Beholding Resurrection
