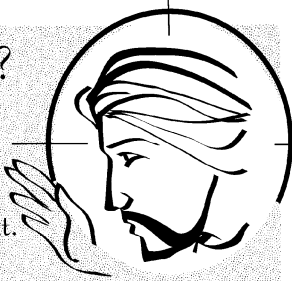


Do you see

Tears of Transformation

Usually tears are not something anyone thinks of as a reason to laugh. Doctors say that tears can release anxiety and be healing to our body and spirit. But most of the time, we try to hide our tears, because in so-called civilized culture, we find tears messy, embarrassing, and maybe a sign of weakness. shouldn't be that easy! And the one thing that separates us from God is being foolishly self-sufficient—instead of realizing our need. When we are judgmental and suspicious like Simon, we end up being too righteous to accept God's forgiveness, and too proud to celebrate God's love as *it really is*. Because God doesn't love like the Pharisees—only following very precise guidelines and rules. Can't you see God laughing at the very idea? Ludicrous! No, God is always overflowing and creating a glorious mess, the way an abundance of wine can overflow the cup... the way tears and sobs of relief can overflow us, when we realize how deeply we are loved, no matter what we have done in our past. "God loves the person, and forgives the sin. Forgiveness means God is present. This prayer was found in a concentration camp in World War II: "O Lord, remember not only the men and women of goodwill, but those of ill-will. "Do not remember all the sufferings they inflicted on us; remember the fruits we have borne thanks to this suffering—our comradeship, our loyalty, our humility... our generosity, our greatness of heart. "And when they come to judgment, let all the fruits that we have borne be their forgiveness." Go in peace to love and serve our God.
