

Spiritual Feeding Frenzy

Before feeding the 5000, Jesus told them to sit on the grass “in groups of about 50.” Why would Luke include this tiny detail? Perhaps to show us that Jesus respects human nature. Jesus knows that both spiritual and physical nourishment happen when people come face to face with each other. Intimacy and true sharing begin in that small unit of mother, father, and child, then grow outward to include neighbors and partners in learning, work, and life. One of the beauties of church life is that we can form many smaller ministries and communities for prayer and sharing, such as Basic Christian Communities, women’s retreat groups, healing groups, and so on. Small groups bring the life of Christ to the community when they constantly look outside their own membership, and move wider to invite others, or to meet needs outside their own circle. But the opposite is also true: when groups become too self-satisfied, they resist newcomers. Many people have said, “I left that church because no one spoke to me.” We all know what that feels like—it’s the opposite of community. So, if we’re in a smaller group that we sense has become a closed group, something has gone wrong. Or, just notice at Mass the people who sit alone or on the outer fringes. Why not make it a point to begin greeting them, and see where this leads? What if we assumed that everyone we meet is coming to US for feeding just as if it were Jesus? Don’t panic. Let your “2 fish and 3 loaves of bread” just take the form of being alert and present, kind and inviting, to the person coming toward you. Go in peace to love and serve our God.

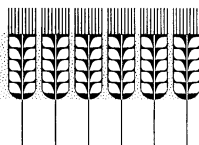
