Today we celebrate what we can easily call the central mystery at the core of our Christian beliefs, the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. It is one of those mysteries that we were probably told we wouldn't be able to comprehend anyway, so we would simply have to take it on faith. But it is not a lack of faith which causes us to ask questions. We have a sacred obligation to ask good questions, to read, pray, and ponder the possibilities—all in our quest to know God more deeply. In fact, the study of theology is defined as "faith seeking understanding." The most important thing is not HOW Father, Son, and Holy Spirit exist as One—but WHY their life as One is crucial to OUR life. Because the Holy Trinity is the model of all love which exists in the world as we know it, and in the world beyond. Not a clinging, weak, dependent love... not a one-sided, temporary, or troubled love, like so many of the "loves" we have all experienced in our lives... but the richest, strongest, most glorious explosion and implosion of energy that has ever existed. Often the relationships we call "love" are not worthy of the name. We are all burdened and blinded by the presence of evil in the world, so we mistake all kinds of phony things for love. And, kids, especially, listen to this. Maybe you have tried to get love by controlling others, by dressing or acting a certain way, or pretended to be needy to draw someone in. Then you are being a "poser," lying to yourself and others. Don't lower your standards! Our guide to intimate relationships should be the real thing. Only the Trinity shows us the awesome ultimate bond that we should seek in all of our love relationships. Go in peace to love and serve our God! (Trinity Sunday – June 7, 2009)
