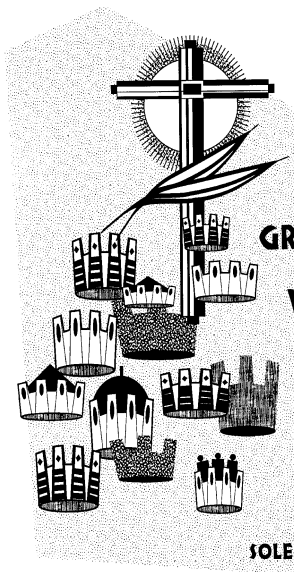


As The Saints Go Marching In

Remember the funny movie called "The Mask" where a meek banker named Stanley Ipkiss gained incredible powers when he put on a mysterious mask? When he's cornered by the police, he whips out some huge machine guns, and breaks into a Clint Eastwood impression: "So--you have to ask yourself one question: Do you feel lucky?" Well, today on the feast of All Saints Day, do you feel lucky--to be a follower of Jesus Christ? Seems like a strange question, but we talk about luck as we buy a lottery ticket, we say "good luck" to friends, and we might even go to the casino or the bingo hall with our lucky troll dolls, or carrying a rabbit's foot. But today Jesus goes up on a mountain to teach the crowds that there is something more basic in our lives than "dumb luck." We don't need luck, because God has created us in the state of blessedness, out of God's own heart. All Saints Day celebrates everyone who is on the path of living out this blessedness. Another word for "blessedness" is "beatitude". Today Jesus describes "The Beatitudes" as all the blessings of the Christian life. For example, "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness..." When we see evil and say, "God, where are you? Where is the justice in this world?", Jesus says we are actually blessed to feel this longing. And "Blessed are you who mourn..." Are you grieving a loss right now? Jesus himself has mourned. And Jesus promises us the truth about the Christian life: every true and sacred hunger and longing **WILL BE FILLED!** Saints are all of us, living and dead, who put one foot in front of the other, sincerely *trying to walk the way of the life of Christ*. Remember, sainthood is our life process. And to live in Christ, we don't need luck—just hope! Go in peace, to love and serve our God! (All Saints in Ord. B – Nov. 1, 2009)
