### Campaign Update

As of Monday October 13 another \$23,957 in gifts has been received which brings our total to 33% of our goal. Twenty-three new households have made gifts making the total participation to date 14%. We have four weeks left in the campaign to raise our goal of \$557,500 in cash our pledges by Amen Sunday November 16. With \$184,421 received to date we are confident that our parishioners will respond in gratitude to God for the gift of our church, our faith, and our community and we will easily achieve our goal!


