



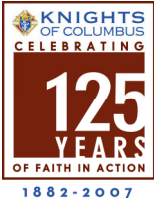

ICCD raffle tickets for a van and cash prize are available at communion breakfasts and the kiosk at the Brandon Shoppers Mall.

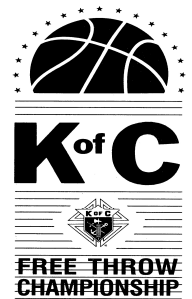


"Adopt A Highway"
